- Prejudiced or harmful comments that encourage discrimination or discriminate on the basis of creed, color, age, religion, gender, gender identity, marital status, political affiliation, national origin, physical or mental disability, veteran status, or sexual orientation;
- Advertisements for commercial services or goods;
- Posts and comments that advocate illegal activity;
- Political statements that endorse or oppose political candidates;
- Obscene or sexual content or links to obscene or sexual content;
- Information that could compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems;
